Nick Winfield

Nick Winfeild, Stahly Engineering, discussed the road study. Nick gave Adams updates on the Warman loop and Soap Creek Bridge. Adam would like to move forward with just the Soap Creek Bridge, which would also result in a cost savings. They have the easement exhibits finished and will have them next week. If the commissioners can get a categorical exclusion, they won't need the NEPA assessment. They are waiting for the appraisal from BIA and they'll also need a JAR (joint action resolution) from the tribe. Nick then went back to discuss the road study project and the maintenance plan. Commissioner Real Bird brings up a guardrail in Rotten Grass that hasn't been fixed. They've missed the window where the cost can be recouped for this project, but it still needs to be fixed. Nick will set up a time to go with Ted Haffeman to see if they can fix it. The Lodge Grass property is in a 100 year flood plain and they can't put a drain field in, they can discuss other options.
